### Shortage of Staff in Government Hospitals, Delhi

(a) what further steps have since been taken to meet the shortage of doctors and staff in the Government hospitals in Delhi and New Delhi; and

(b) whether all the remaining vacancies have been filled up?

**The Minister of Health (Shri Karmarkar):** (a) and (b). In November, 1959, there were 11 vacancies in the posts of Medical Officer in the four Government Hospitals in Delhi and New Delhi. Out of these eleven vacancies, seven were filled by the end of January, 1960 but four new vacancies occurred during that period. At present there are thus eight vacancies, out of which one has been kept in abeyance and against

another vacant post, an appointment letter has been issued to the selected candidate. Necessary action to fill up the remaining vacancies is being taken.
