puts and outputs. Price policy of the Government has played positive role in the modernisation process of agriculture which has significantly increased the yield per hectare of principal crops of rice, jowar, wheat, sugarcane, groundnut, cotton, potato, tobacoo etc. ranging from 0.91 to 3.2 per cent per annum during the years 1967-68 to 1981-82 in the country. Increased productivity coupled with increases in support prices is expected to have contributed to increase in real income of the farmers although no comprehensive study for its assessment for the country has been carried out.

- (b) According to provisional figures of Census of India 1981, 66.69 per cent of the main workers comprising cultivators (41.53 per cent) and agricultural labourers (25.16 per cent) were engaged in agriculture. A number of small and marginal farmers among the cultivators and most of the agricultural labourers buy foodgrains for their consumption needs.
- (c) During the last three years since 1979-80 of the total increase in wholesale price index the share of foodgrains has been 11.6 per cent.
- (d) The objective of Government's policy is to safeguard and promote the interest of the cultivators including small and marginal farmers both as producers as well as consumers of foodgrains. To increase the real income of small and marginal farmers the Government is taking various measures which inter-alia include provision of easy credit, subsidies on agricultural inputs, irrigation, crop insurance, land development etc. In addition the Government spends annually several hundreds of crores of rupees on general subsidy on fertilizers and on foodgrains supplied through public distribution system.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Toned and full cream milk prices were increased by 20 paise per letre w.e.f. 1.4.1983.

The main reasons for enhancing price of Mother Dairy milk are:

(i) Higher price paid to the State Dairy Cooperative Federations for fresh milk.

- - price paid to Indian (ii) Higher Corporation for milk Dairy powder and butter oil.
 - (iii) Increase in diesel price.
 - (iv) Increase in transporatation charges by railways.
- (c) No, Sir, Mother Dairy, Delhi is marketing only liquid milk.
- (d) Price of full cream milk and toned milk which are being marketed by Mother Dairy at present have been raised as under:
