Number of Goats in I.C.A.R. Goat Institute

B.D. SINGH: Will 9675. SHRI the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of goats at ICAR Goat Institute, age-wise and sex-wise of each breed and cross breed monthwise from 1.4.1980 to 1.4.1983;
- (b) annual expenditure incurred on fodder, concentrates and quantity of milk, meat and fibre, separately, produced monthly and corresponding prices of purchase and sale during the above period; and
- (c) steps Government propose to take to normalise operations of ICAR Goat Institute?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICUL-TURE (RAO BIRENDRA SINGH): (a) and (b) The information required is quite voluminous. It is being collectfrom the Central Institute for Research on Goats, Mathura and will be laid on the Table of the Lok Sabha thereafter.

(c) Since the opration of the Institute is quite normal, the question of any steps to normalise operation does not arise.

Unutilsed Tractors/Fertilizers

9676. SHRI G.Y. KRISHNAN: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there are some tractors lying unsold in the country;
- (b) whether some fertilizers is also lying unutilized in the country;
- (c) if so, the details regarding the number of such tractors as well as the quantity of fertilizers lying unutilized;
- (d) the reaction of Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ARIF MOHAMMAD KHAN): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) Yes, Sir.
- (c) At the end of February, 1983, 4,936 nos. of tractors were in stock with the different manufacturers.

As on 1st February, 1983, 16.38 lakh tonnes of fertilisers, in terms of nutrients Nirtogen, Phosphate Potash, were in stock.

(d) In the context of need to curb inflationary pressures on the economy, the Reserve Bank of India had to take several measures to contain the volume of the credit expansion and to reduce the liquidity in the economy. However, taking into account the need of credit for tractor sales, the Reserve Bank of India authorised Agricultural Refinance Development, Corporation (new National Bank of Agriculture and Rural Development) to provide additional refinance facilities for tractor sales, which have picked up in recent months.

The Government's policy is to boost consumption of fertilisers in order to step up agricultural production. Adequate buffer stocks have to be maintained to take care of exigencies, such as, aberrations in fertilisers production and erratic supplies from abroad, sudden drop or rise in demand and weather conditions, Government is taking all possible steps to accelerate the pace of lifting of fertilisers.

Maps of the Forest in Karnataka
