Fixation of Seniority of Commercial Inspectors

1881. SHRI R. N. RAKESH: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) number of the Commercial Apprentices who after completing 2 years training in 1981 in Z. T. S. School Chandausi were posted as Commercial Inspectors in the respective Divisions over Northern Railway;

(b) the number and grade of those Commercial Inspectors whose seniority has been fixed, and number of those whose seniority has not been fixed so far;

(c) the reasons for not fixing the seniority; and

(d) what steps the Government propose to take in this regard so that their *inter se* seniority of the training school is restored to them?
