- 4. Checking of night trains by supervisory police officers has been ordered.
- 5. Police pickets have been Jeputed at vulnerable stations.
- 6. CID of the State Governments are providing special escorts to assist in the investigation of important cases.
- . 7. Augmentation of the Government Railway Police Force by 7000 mers has been approved.
- (d) All railway developmental works like track renewal, manning of unmanned level crossings, improvement in signalling and telecommunication aids, provision of speedometers on locos, improvement in maintenance facilities for rolling stock etc. have an important bearing on safety of train operation. As such it is difficult to isolate precisely the cost of safety measures. However, the funds available in the recent past has been inadequate for implementing safety measures to full extent. Allocation for the year 1982-83 has been Rs. 150.5 crores for track renewals, Rs. 30 crores for signalling and safety and Rs. 4.7 crores for manning of unmanned level crossings.

The expenditure by the Railways on augmentation of Government Railway Police force by 7000 men will be of the order of Rs. 15 crores per annum.

## Merger of Shipping Corporation of India and Mogul Line Ltd.
