Separate Employment Exchange for Job Seekers Abroad

5710. SHRI K. MALLANNA: Will the Minister of LABOUR AND REHABI-LITATION be pleased to state:

- (b) if so, whether Government propose to establish a separate Employment Exchange through which foreign going job seekers may get their names registered to stop their exploitation by the so-called agents; and
