- (b) The aggregation of losses and profits of there undertakings led to a net profit of Rs. 18.74 crores during 1981-82.
- (c) The causes for losses in the loss making undertakings include shortage of, and inadequate availabitity of, uninterupted power, shortage of raw materials particularly steel in matching sections, shortage or free supply items from the customers, lack of adequate orders in the desired product-mix and shortage of funds.
