MINISTER OF PLANNING THE (SHRI S.B. CHAVAN) : (a) Government is already granting Special Assistance for development of the backward areas of Orssa. These schemes are for accelerated development in tribal areas, drought prone alreas and industrially backward areas of the State.

(b) and (c) The Special Central Assistance provided for the schemes in the year 1983-84 is as follows :--

1387.34 (1) Tribal Areas

(2) Drought Prone Areas - Programme 130,00

(3) Industrially Backward Areas

*No fixed provision is made. The amount is reimbursed according to needs and eligibility.

The Special Central Assistance for tribal areas is for the development of 23 Integrated Tribal Development Projects and tribal pockets in the State. The Drought Prone Areas Programme is in operation in two districts viz. Kalahandi and Phulbani. The industrially backward districts in the State numbering 8 (Balasore, Bolangir, Dhenkanal, Kalahandi, Keonjhar, Koraput, Mayurbhanj and Phulbani) are eligible for concessional finance from the financial institutions, while 6 districts (Kalahandi, Mayurbhani, Bolangir, Dhenkanal, Keonjhar and Koraput) eligible for Investment Subsidy for setting up industries.

Licence for Manufacture of T.V. Picture Tubes

for Black and White TV picture tubes, three applications for industrial approvals have been received and are being processed for decision. These applications are from units located in Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and Orissa. Regarding colour TV picture tubes conversion to an industrial licence of the letter of Intent already issued to M/s Puniab Display Devices Limited, a public sector company of the Government of Punjab is being processed for decision. In addition, two new applications, one each from the Andhra Pradesh Electronics Development Corporation and the Uttar Pradesh Electronics Corporation, have been received and are also being processed for decision.
