The Conference stressed the urgent need to improve recovery performance of Cooperative Institutions. As the peak season for recovery of cooperative overdues is approaching the Registrars will step up the tempo of recovery and in respect of overdue amounts coercive measures will be initiated on a priority basis to recover overdues from "bigger defaulters".

To provide timely relief to farmers affected by natural calamities, the Conference suggested measures for conversion of short term loans into medium term loans.

For strengthening the primary agricultural Credit Societies at the grass root level, the Conference suggested that the existing margins available to State Central Cooperative Banks and Primary Societies should be reviewed with a view to increasing the margins to Primaries.

Credit support to beneficiaries the IRD programme should receive priority of attention of Cooperatives.

The role of Cooperatives in the distribution of fertilizers is to be further expanded. Presently, Co-operatives are distributing nearly 47 per cent of fertilizers in the country. In this connection, the Registrars pointed the need for increasing the margins to Cooperatives to render the business of fertilizer distribution functioning viable. Cooperatives are to be associated in a big way for distribution of seeds produced by National Seeds Corporation.

The Conference recommended that the Government of India should constitute a Committee to review cooperative and administration to ensure smooth and efficient functioning of cooperatives. Study Teams may be set up for major crops to consider measures for expanding inter-state and export trade in agricultural produce by Cooperatives necessary coordination between Primaries and State and National level Cooperative Marketing Federation.

The Conference recommended measures for improving the operational efficiency of Cooperatives through proper recruitment and training programmes.

While the Cooperative Sugar Industry now accounts for 55 per cent of national production of sugar, some sugar factories have become "sick" for various reasons. The Registrars recommended a programme for rehabilitation with financial support.

The Conference noted that the spontaneous efforts of cotton growers who have formed themselves into Cooperatives and contributed substantial amounts of share capital for establishing Cooperative Spinning Mills, have not been encouraged in the absence of adequate plan outlays and support from term lending They urged full institutions. from Government and financing institutions for this programme.

Cooperatives are running nearly 72,000 fair price shops of which 58,000 are in rural areas. This activity of Cooperatives is to be further strengthened and enlarged. The Registrars recommended that margins available to Co-operatives for distribution of essential commodities be reconsidered with a view to rendering this business functioning viable.

Non-Procurement of Paddy by FCI in Thanjavur

- (c) whether the officials concerned are justified in keeping the rice mills idle in this surplus district; and
- (d) if not, what actions Government proposed to take against those responsible for their lapses and to avoid such

The procurement of paddy in Thanjavur District out of Kuruvai crop was not entrusted to the Food Corporation of India by the Government of Tamil Nadu, Procurement was, however, made by the State Civil Supplies Corporation. Food Corporation of India had sufficient stocks of paddy for its four modern rice mills in the State and as such they did not remain idle for want of paddy.
