

ributed to the expected shortfall in the kharif groundnut crop 1983 due to drought conditions in some parts of the country.

(d) The present production of indigenous edible oils is not adequate to meet the entire demand for such oils in the country. To meet this gap a number of steps have been taken by the Government. These include:—

(i) Increasing the production and productivity of oilseeds and development of newer oilseeds of promise.

(ii) Planned efforts to exploit non-traditional sources of oils such as rice bran, oilseeds of tree and forest origin namely salseeds, etc.

(iii) Continuing import of adequate quantity of edible oils as a temporary measure to tide over the situation.

(e) The quantity of oils to be imported during the year 1983-84 would depend upon a number of factors such as the anticipated production of indigenous oils, price trends in the internal and international markets, foreign exchange position, etc.

#### **Expenditure on Asiad**

Will the Minister of SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) how much amount was sanctioned and spent from the Central budget on the IX Asian Games held in New Delhi;

(b) how much amount was allotted/spent by the DDA on the construction of five-over-bridges/Asian villages complex and roads etc.;

(c) what is the total amount allocated to New Delhi Municipal Committee for the construction of over-bridges, stadia and hotels etc.;

(d) how much amount was allocated/spent on the ring railway; and

(e) how much amount was allocated/spent on the sports goods and articles used during the Asian Games including the foreign components?

SINGH):** (a) The sanctioned budget so far for incurring expenditure on IX Asian Games is Rs. 60.86 crores. The expenditure booked up to 28-2-83 by Department of Sports on Asian Games is Rs. 55.23 crores.

(b) They have spent Rs. 36.80 crores on the residential complex near Siri Fort. The amount spent on the residential complex near Siri Fort is part of the normal development expenditure of DDA for providing additional residential accommodation in Delhi and is not considered expenditure on Asiad. Its use for Asia was incidental. The Delhi Development Authority have incurred to expenditure on over-bridges, roads etc.

(c) Government have allocated an amount of Rs. 6.27 crores out of the Asian Games budget to New Delhi Municipal Committee as Government's contribution towards the construction of Swimming Pool at Talkotra Gardens. No other amount has been allocated to New Delhi Municipal Committee out of the Asian Games budget.

(d) No amount was allocated out of the Asian Games budget for Ring Railway, which forms part of the normal development programme of the Railway Ministry.

(e) An amount of Rs. 2 crores was allocated out of the Asian Games Budget for the purchase of equipment for the conduct of the Asian Games. Out of this, Netaji Subhas National Institute of Sports Patiala has reported an expenditure of Rs. 1.44 crores.
