Post of Draughtsmen and Tracers vacant in Doordarshan

2686. SHRI GHULAM MOHAMMAD KHAN: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) number of posts of Draughtsmen and Tracers lying vacant in AIR and Doordarshan Directorate and the dates since when they are lying vacant;

(b) the reasons thereof; and

(c) time likely to be taken to fill up the vacant posts?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) 6 posts in AIR and 2 posts in Doordarshan in 2 grades of Draughtsmen have been vacant. Out of these, 6 posts fell vacant in 1982 and 2 in 1981. No posts of Tracer exists in Doordarshan. In AIR 5 posts are vacant out of which 4 fell vacant in 1982 and 1 in 1981.

(b) and (c). Every effort is being taken to fill up the vacancies which are to be filled up either by a promotion from amongst the departmental candidates or by direct recruitment through Employment Exchange, as per the existing rules. For promotion from the Departmental candidates, DPCs have either been held or have been fixed to be convened and for direct recruitment, requisitions have been sent to the concerned Local Employment Exchanges. It is expected that the posts will be filled up very shortly.

Joint Survey by Indian and USSR in West Bengal for Oil and Gas

2687. SHRI SANAT KUMAR MANDAL: Will the Minister of ENERGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether a joint survey by Indian and Soviet oil experts has revealed that more than 54,000 sq. km. area in West Bengal offers bright prospects for obtaining oil and gas deposits; and

(b) if so, the action taken to explore the area and assess its commercial potentiality?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PETROLEUM IN THE MINISTRY OF ENERGY (SHRI GARGI SHANKAR MISHRA): (a) No, Sir. An area of only 11,000 sq. km. in West Bengal has been assessed as highly prospective.

(b) Exploration is continuing in the areas of interest.
