Air-Conditioning Of Departure Lounges At Airports

7500. SHRI NAVIN RAVANI : Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state :

(a) the names of the airports which have been provided with the facility of air conditioning at Departure Lounges;

(b) whether there is any proposal to provide such facilities in other airports also ; and

(c) if so, the names of those airports and by when it will be provided there ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI KHUR-SHEED ALAM KHAN) : (a) The four international airports at Delhi, Bombay, Calcutta and Madras including their security hold lounges, for both domestic as well as international passenger traffic, are air conditioned.

None of the domestic airports other than international airports have air conditioning facilities in the Departure Lounges.

(b) and (c) It is proposed to air-condition only the departure areas at Ahmedabad, Patna, Tiruchirapally, Trivandrum and Varanasi airports. This work is likely to be completed by March, 1984;

The departure holding area in the New terminal at Dabolim (under-construction) is also being air conditioned and is likely to be completed by 30th September, 1983.

(a) whether any survey had been made for demand by various countries for coloured varieties and colourful fish which are abundant around Lakshadweep and other places in our country ;

(b) what is India's share in the export of ornamental fish and ancilliary products ; and

(c) the steps taken to increase the products ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRIMATI RAM DULARY SINHA) :

(a) No, Sir.

(b) India's share in the export of ornamental fish and ancilliary products forms a very negligible portion of the world trade in these items.
