Major Irrigation Schemes in Himachal Pradesh

1828. Shri S. N. Ramaul: Will the Minister of Irrigation and Power be pleased to state:

(a) the number of major irrigation schemes (above Rs. 50,000) taken in hand by the Himachal Pradesh Administration during the First and Second Five Year Plans in Mahasu and Sirmur District;

(b) the names of such schemes and their location;

(c) how many of them have been successfully completed so far; and

(d) the reasons for non-completion of the rest?

The Deputy Minister of Irrigation and Power (Shri Hathi): (a) There are no major and medium irrigation schemes in Himachal Pradesh. Schemes costing below Rs. 10 lakhs are minor irrigation schemes.

(b) to (d). Do not arise.

Bridge on River Jumna

(a) whether it is a fact that construction of a bridge on river Jumna on Rohru-Rajban Road, in District Sirmur, Himachal Pradesh, which was

in the initial stages of construction, has since been postponed; and

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Transport and Communications (Shri Raj Bahadur): (a) and (b). No, Sir. The work of trial borings has been completed. An estimate of cost for the bridge work has been received and is expected to be sanctioned shortly.
