(ग) और (घ) देश में काम कर रहे दो परमाणु बिजलीघरों के रिऐक्टरों को आवश्यक अनुरक्षण और मरम्मत के लिए समय-समय पर बंद किया जाता है।

### Trade pact between India and Hungary

2948. SHRI ARVIND NETAM: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether a trade pact has been signed between India and Hungary in the recent past;

(b) if so, the details of the pact;

(c) the names and status of the leader and other members of Indian delegation who visited Hungary;

(d) similar information about Hungarian counterparts with whom Indian delegation had discussions; and

(e) the extent to which India is a beneficiary?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI NARAYAN DATT TIWARI):

(a) and (b). No trade pact has been signed between India and Hungary in the recent past. However, the 5th session of the Indo-Hungarian Joint Commission on Economic, Scientific and Technical Co-operation was held at Budapest from 8th to 12th November, 1982, on the conclusion of which a protocol was signed.

(c) and (d). The details of the members of the Indian and Hungarian delegation are at attached statement.

(e) The discussions covering a wide area including Industrial Cooperation and cooperation in the agricultural sector, Commerce, and Drugs and Pharmaceuticals are expected to benefit both the countries.
