(f) the efforts proposed to be made to give due place to all the regional languages in the Regional Chitrahar Programme?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING AND IN THE DEPART-MENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN) : (a) The viewership of Doordarshan Kendra, Delhi consists of people from various linguistic regions of India. The regional Chitrahar programme of Doordarshan Kendra, Delhi is meant for entertainment of viewers while also giving them an idea of the cultural variety of various regions.

(b) and (c) Detailed account of all the languages in which song and dance sequences have been telecast by Doordarshan Kendra, Delhi in the regional Chitrahar programme since its inception is not available. However, sequences from films in the following languages are telecast :-

(d) and (e) The number of feature films produced in Oriya language is less compared to some other regional languages. Paucity of films in Oriya language is the main reason for the comparatively less number of sequences from Oriya films telecast in the regional Chitrahar programmes of Doordarshan Kendra, Delhi.

(f) Inclusion of film song sequence in a particular language in the regional Chitrahar programme is subject to the availability of films produced in that language. Doordarshan is evolving a system of obtaining film song sequences in regional language from different linguistic zones.
