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- (b) if so, the exact terms of its reference along with functions and powers;
- (c) whether the Committee has so far identified any specific areas of research essential for realistic planning for development of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes or have invited suggestions of appropriate research topics from the concerned scholars and institutions;
- (d) if so, the particulars thereof; and
- (e) whether the question of establishing a Central Research and Training Institute for SCs. and STs. which was under Government's consideration since the Fourth Five Year Plan would now be given high priority for facilitating the work of the Committee?

THE MINISTER OF PLANNING (SHRI S. B. CHAVAN): A Committee to advise the Planning Commission on research in areas relating to planning has been set up under the chairmanship of Prof. S. Chakravarty.

- (b) A copy each of the Resolution constituting the Committee and of the notifications indicating subsequent changes is laid on the Table of the House. (Placed in Library, See No. LT—6431/83)
- (c) and (d) The Committee has identified certain broad areas research from the point of view of overall planning. It is essentially concerned with the promotion of integrated and coordinated research, sharply focused on the requirements of planning, with a view to helping the Planning Commission in the formulation implementation of Plans. Studies to scheduled castes relating scheduled tribes, which have a direct bearing on Plan formulation or implementation, could also be sponsored as part of the overall research programme.
- (c) The question of establishing a National Institute for Research and Training on Tribal Development has

been recently taken up for examination by the Ministry of Home Affairs.

## Adoption of Tribal Sub-Plan Concept

- 8049. SHRI BHEEKHABHAI: Will the Minister of HOME Affairs be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the concept of tribal sub-plan conceived carlier has neither been adopted nor implemented by States and Union Territories;

- (d) if so, the contribution made by each Ministry or Central Government Department ever since its conception from the year 1975?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NIHAR RANJAN LASKAR): (a) No, Sir. The concept of tribal sub-Plan has been adopted and implemented in 17 States and 2 Union Territories.

- (b) The triable sub-Plan is to be prepared by pooling resources from (i) outlays from State Plans (ii) investment by Central Ministries (iii) Special Central Assistance of the Home Ministry, and (iv) institutional finance. In addition to the attempt at such financial integration, administrative integration is sought to be achieved at the ITDP level by involving representatives of various development departments. In some States, Such integration has been, by and large, achieved.
  - (c) Yes, Sir.
- (d) Central Ministries/Departments started quantification of funds since 1978-79 for the tribal areas. A statement showing the contribution made by them is enclosed.
