and natural habits of the sea turtles available in the Bay of Bengal?

Written Answers

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRON-MENT (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH): (a) Sea turtles are included in Schedule I of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 and no hunting of this species is normally permitted.

- (b) and (c) Some major initiatives have been taken by the Central Government for the conservation of sea Turtles. These are as follows:
  - (i) Regular watch is being maintained at the nesting site along the beaches and checkposts have been established on the highways along which the poached sea turtles are transported.
  - (ii) Special instructions have been given to the West Bengal Government to stop their sale in the Calcutta markets.
  - (iii) Help of the Coast Guard authorities has been taken in patrolling the coastal waters and in apprehending vessels of poachers, Constant vigil is, thus, being maintained along the coast.
  - (iv) In addition, publicity is being given to the fact that the sea turtles are protected species and that their collection, hunting or sale is totally banned. Captive programmes for breeding rehabilitation of the sea turtles has also been undertaken with technical assistance from the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute.
- (d) No specific scheme has been drawn up for this purpose. However, studies on the breeding biology of sea turtles are being conducted. A specialist group is being set up which will also consider this matter.

## Import of Cement

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI NARAYAN DATT TIWARI): (a) and (b) Countries from which imports were effected during the last three years include South Korca, D.P.R. Korea, Japan, Indonesia, Philippines, Vietnam, Taiwan & Poland. The import of cement during the last three years has been as under:

- (c) and (d) working Group on Cement Industry (1980-85) had on the basis of certain assumptions indicated a projected demand of around 35 million tonnes of cement within the country by 1983-84. The production of cement is expected to be of the order of 28 million tonnes in the same year,
- (e) every effort is being made to increase production of cement in the country by making available infrastructure inputs to the extent possible.

- (b) The proposal for starting a micro project for the Puttasingi Lanjia Soura was initiated during 1980-81 and the Tribal and Harijan Research-cum-Training Institute was requested to prepare a project Report on the basis of detailed family-wise survey,
- (c) and (d) It is not a fact that study of only Puttasingi Micro project was entrusted to Tribal and Harijan Researchcum-Training Institute. preparation of five other Micro-projects, namely, Gadaba. Lodha, Birhor, Erenga, Kolha, Kutia Kondh, Hill Kharia and Mankadia was also entrusted to the Institute for similar studies.

The project report has recently been received by the Government of Orissa and it has been sent to Collector, Koraput, for his comments by the State Government. The Tribal and Harijan Research-cum-Training Institute, Bhubaneswar, has also prepared micro-project reports on Gadaba, Lodha, Birhor, Erenga, Kolha, Kutia, Kondh, Hill Kharia and Mankdia. These reports are under examination by the State Government.

(d) Preparation of the project Report was initiated in 1980-81 and the said report has since been received by and is under active consideration of the State Government.
