TARY AFFAIRS,

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMEN-SPORTS WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI BUTA SINGH): (a) The total plan allocation of funds at the centre on promotion of Sports in the country during the Sixth Five Year Plan Period is Rs. 1075 lakhs. This does not include the allocation of Rs. 125 lakhs kept for Physical Education.

- expenditure on Asian (b) The total Games booked upto 15-2-83 in the Department of Sports is Rs. 51.02 crores.
- (c) Special Organising Committee IX Asian Games had earned Rs. 5.84 crores upto 31-1-83.
- (d) According to present indications, the total expenditure on Asian Games is likely to be of the order of Rs. 67 crores.
- (e) The Asiad stadia will remain available to sportsmen and women for a long time to come. The Delhi Development Authority is expected to ensure continued utility of the Asiad Village Complex.
- (f) The expenditure incurred on Asian Games is mainly on the creation of infra-structure and other facilities and are intended to be utilised for promotion of Sports in the country. They are not in the nature of commercial ventures. The question of recovery of the expenditure incurred by Government on Asiad does not, therefore, arise.

Proposals from States for Central Assisfor development of Selected Regulated Markets

58. SHR1 SHANTUBHAI PATEL: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOP-MENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of proposals received from various States for Central Assistance for development of Selected Regulated Markets in 1981-82;
- (b) the number of proposals approved for each State and the number pending as of today;

- (c) State-wise distribution of funds for Regulated Markets during each of the jast three years; and
- (d) the number of Regulated Markets developed as a result thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOP-MENT (SHRI HARINATHA MISRA): (a) and (b). The information State-wise regarding the number of proposals received for grant of central assistance under the scheme for development of selected regulated markets and the number of proposals approved during the year 1981-82 is given in the statement at Annexure-I laid on the table of the House. [Placed in Library. See No. LT-5792 [83]. The proposals which did not meet the requirements of the scheme were returned the concerned State Governments. No proposal of the year 1981-82 is pending with this Ministry.

State-wise villagers facing drinking water problems

- 59. SHRI JAI NARAYAN ROAT: Will the Minister of AND WORKS HOUSING be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that tribal areas are facing drinking water problem; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and steps taken by Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMEN-TARY AFFAIRS. SPORTS AND WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI BUTA SINGH): (a) and (b). The programme for the supply of drinking water administered by this Ministry covers problem villages in all Parts of the country including tribal areas. According to the data received from the State Governments, there were about 2.31 lakhs problem villages in the country as on 1st April, 1980. Problem villages are those which suffer from chronic scarcity or with unsafe sources of water. The problem villages are spread over all areas including tribal belts.

Supply of drinking water to the problem villages has been included in the new 20 Point Programme. During the sixth Plan, the effort will be to cover all the identified problem villages with atleast one source of safe potable water available throughout the year. The needs of the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes population in the rural areas will be given due priority in the implementation of this programme. The outlay for the programme in the Sixth Five Year Plan has been stepped upto Rs. 2007.11 crores compared to Rs. 429.27 crores in the Fifth Plan (1974—79).

Additional Irrigation Target for the Sixth Plan

60. SHRI JAIPAL SINGH KASHYAP: SWAMY INDERVESH:

Will the Minister of IRRIGATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the additional irrigation target planned for the Sixth Plan is not likely to be achieved; and
- (b) if so, what is the anticipated shortfall in the achievement of irrigation target during the Sixth Plan period and what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRODHA): (a) and (b) Against a target of 13.74 million hectares, during the first three years of the Plan, 7.06 million hectares of potential are expected to be created upto June 1983. With the same rate of achievement in the remaining two years, a further potential of 4.7 million hectares may be expected in the remaining two years of the Plan. Thus the likely shortfall will be about 2 million hectares.

The main reason for the shortfall is financial constraints due to the escalation in the costs.

Administrative and Financial problems of Slum Improvement Schemes

- 61. SHRI SONTOSH MOHAN DEV: Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the slums improvement schemes have not met any progress due to legal and administrative problems and financial shortcomings; and
- (b) what steps are proposed to speedily implement the slums improvement schemes?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMEN-AFFAIRS. SPORTS WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI BUTA SINGH): (a) and (b) The reasons for slow progress in the implementation of the scheme for Environmental Improvement of urban slums include shortcomings in the adequate provision of funds, institutional arrangements, involvement of the community, effective monitoring, building materials supply and maintenance of the assets created. The State Governments UT administrations have been requested to take necessary steps in order to accelerate the implementation of the programme and achieve the targets fixed. 'Slum Improvement' being in the State sector, it is for the State Governments to take suitable remedial measures. scheme is being constantly monitored by the Central Government under the 20-Point Programme.
