

sored Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme to supplement the outlay of Rs. 1407.11 crores in the State sector Minimum Needs Programme to provide safe drinking water to identified problem villages. The progress in the coverage of problem villages during the year 1981-82 (the first year of the Decade in India) State-wise is shown in the statement attached. The target for the year 1982-83 is to cover about 42,000 problem villages.

### Operation Flood Schemes in States

73. SHRI HARIHAR SOREN: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the name of the States where Centrally sponsored operation flood programme is under implementation;

(b) since when such programme has been launched in different states;

(c) whether such programme has been launched in Orissa;

(d) if so, how many districts of that State have been covered under the above programme so far; and

(e) the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) and (b). As statement is attached.

(c) Yes, Sir.

(d) and (e). Districts of Dhenkanal, Keonjhar, Puri and Cuttack are covered under the programme. The Indian Dairy Corporation released funds for implementation of Operation Flood II Project in Orissa in September 1980 and field programmes were initiated on 2nd October 1980. Expansion of Phulnakhara Dairy Plant from 6,000 litres to 10,000 litres per day is in progress. Sites have been selected for Liquid Milk Plant at Rourkela and Cattle Feed Plant at Cuttack. Construction of 10,000 litres per day Chilling Centres at Dhenkanal and Keonjhar has started.
