Expansion of Plant from 6,000 litres to 10,000 litres per day is in progress. Sites have been selected for Liquid Milk Plant at Rourkela and Cattle Feed Plant at Cuttack. Construction of 10,000 litres per day Chilling Centres as Dhenkanal and Keonjhar has stanted
