Shortage of Fertiliser

87. SHRI G. Y. KRISHNAN: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that there is shortage of fertilisers in the country vis-a-vis the demand therefor;

(b) if so, the details in this regard; and

(c) what measures have been adopted by Government for self-sufficiency, specially in the Sixth Five Year Plan period?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ARIF MOHAMMAD KHAN): (a) No,

Sir. There are adequate stocks available of the indigenous as well as imported fertilizer to meet the current level of demand.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) Substantial expansion of capacity is being planned so as to narrow considerably the gap between demand and indigenous production of fertilisers. However, the production of fertilisers by the end of the Sixth Five Year Plan (1984-85) is expected to fall short of the estimated demand of fertilisers. This position has been recognised in the Plan itself.
