Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the approximate production of Sugar, Rice, Onion and other agricultural produce in the country during the year 1982-83 till now;

(b) the quantity of the above produce exported during the same period; and

(c) the losses or profits accrued therefrom?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ARIF MOHAMMAD KHAN): (a) Estimates of production of crops for the crop year 1982-83 have not yet become available. Sugar production during 1982-83 have not yet become available. Sugar production during 1982-83 (October 1982—January 1983) is 32.76 lakh tonnes.

(b) A statement showing the provisional estimates of export of selected agricultural and allied products (including plantation) for the first half of 1982-83 (April—September) is enclosed.

(c) Most of these commodities are exported on private account and therefore, figures of losses or profits from above exports are not available. However, sugar exports are canalised through S.T.C. which exported 5 lakh tonnes of sugar during 1982 and is likely to incur a loss of Rs. 58 crores.
