- (b) Follow up action has been completed on two out of the three subjects on which recommendations had been made by the Seminar. The following statement explains the position:—
- 1. Apportionment of cost and allptment of reservoir storage space for hydel power, irrigation, navigation and flood control schemes in multipurpose projects.

The report of the Sub-committee, as accepted by the Seminar has been commended to all State Governments/Project authorities on 26-11-60 for information and guidance.

 Establishment of Supergrids and organisational procedure for their control.

The resolution of the Seminar regarding the establishment of a Cell in the C.W.&P.C., to take up the question of Planning regional Supergrids in association with the State Electricity Boards and Public Electric Supply Under-takings and Corporations, has been examined The necessary proposals for the creation of this Cell are in the process of formulation.

It is also proposed to secure the services of a foreign expert for a limited period, under the T.C.M. Programme, to render necessary technical assistance in the planning and design of Super-Grid System.

 Rationalisation of the procedure for disposal of surplus machinery on projects including revision of the formula for calculating depreciation of machinery.

All the recommendations made by the Seminar Sub-Committee have been accepted by Government, subject to a minor modification in the provision relating to the calculation of minimum depreciation. The recommendations have been commended to State Governments/Project authorities on 9-12-60 for implementation
