(a) the total number of cases of rape in the Union Territory of Delhi in the year 1982-83, month-wise; and

(b) the names of the police officials of Delhi against whom cases of rape have been reported and inquiry is going on?

### Visit of Czech delegation and collaboration offer for Vizag project

(a) whether a high-powered delegation from Czechoslovakia recently visited India and offered collaboration in the Visakhapatnam project to produce energy;

(b) if so, the details of the discussions about the agreement held between the visiting delegation and Indian counterparts and the extent to which India agreed to the offer;

(c) the details of items for the Visakhapatnam project assured to be supplied by Czechoslovakia, the cost thereof and what will be the mode of payment;

(d) the extent to which the project will be able to produce energy; and

(e) whether any technology has been sought from West Germany, UK., U.S.A., France etc. if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI N. K. P. SALVE): (a) No, Sir. However, a Czechoslovak firm has participated in an international tender for supply of equipment for the thermal power plant for Visakhapatnam Steel Plant. Its bid will be considered by the project authorities along-with other bids that have been received.
