

June, 1979. The conclusions arrived at were circulated to State Governments/UT Administrations for implementation. Most of the recommendations have either been implemented or are at various stages of implementation.

(d) 'Police' is a subject in the State List under the Constitution. The question of earmarking funds at the Centre for the implementation of the recommendations does not arise.

(e) and (f). The National Police Commission submitted eight reports. The First report has already been considered by Government. The Second and subsequent report has already been considered by likely to be placed on the Table of the House in the current Session of Parliament.

खादी भवन के भूतपूर्व मैनेजर के विरुद्ध

4051. श्री राम अबध : क्या उद्योग मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या केन्द्रीय जांच ब्यूरो ने खादी भवन, नई दिल्ली के भूतपूर्व मैने-

जर के विरुद्ध अपने पद तथा सार्वजनिक धन के दुरुपयोग के आरोपों की जांच की है ; और

(ख) यदि हां, तो तत्संबंधी जांच प्रतिवेदन का ब्यौरा क्या है और खादी आयोग द्वारा इस संबन्ध में अब तक क्या कार्यवाही की गई है ?

उद्योग मंत्री (श्री नारायण दत्त तिवारी) : (क) केन्द्रीय जांच ब्यूरो (सी० बी० आई०) ने खादी भवन दिल्ली के एक भूतपूर्व प्रबन्धक पर लगाए गए कुछ आरोपों की जांच की है और अपनी रिपोर्ट प्रस्तुत कर दी है।

(ख) सी० बी० आई० ने उक्त कर्मचारी को भारी दण्ड देने के लिए उसके विरुद्ध नियमित विभागीय कार्यवाही करने की सिफारिश की है। तदनुसार खादी तथा ग्रामोद्योग आयोग ने अब विभागीय कार्यवाही शुरू कर दी है। कार्यवाही अभी समाप्त नहीं हुई है।

Manufacturing of Picture tubes by Large Capacity Plants

(a) whether it is a fact that Government have invited proposals from large capacity plants for mass production of picture tubes for the black and white TV sets in order to meet the shortage of such tubes; and

(b) if so, what would be its effect on the small scale sector which are engaged in the manufacture of such tubes?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONICS (SHRI M. S. SANJEEVI RAO): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The item is not produced in the small scale sector and as such the question does not arise.
