

Visit of Soviet Delegation to make joint Research in India

4053. **SHRI BABURAO PARANJPE:** Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have seen a news item appearing in the *Patriot*, dated 28 January, 1983 under the caption "Climatic changes and monsoon behaviour—Marchuk proposes joint research";

(b) if so, the names and status of the leader and other members of Soviet delegation who visited India, names of Indian counter-parts with whom they had discussion and out-come thereof;

(c) the names of places visited by the visiting delegation; and

(d) the details of suggestions given by the visiting delegation for the joint research with particular reference to the development of science and technology?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, ATOMIC ENERGY, SPACE, ELECTRONICS AND OCEAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SHIVRAJ V. PATIL): (a) Yes, Sir. There is an on going programme of cooperation on the monsoon behaviour between India and USSR under bilateral programme of cooperation for the period 1980—83.

(b) A list of names and status of the leader and other members of Soviet delegation who visited India is enclosed in the Statement I attached. The names of the Indian Scientists and other dignitaries whom the delegation met in India are given in the Statement II attached.

(c) The delegation visited New Delhi, Bombay, Bangalore, Khajuraho and Agra.

(d) The discussion related to implementation of the ongoing programme of cooperation in S&T between India and USSR in areas like catalysis etc. and possible areas of future cooperation
