Trade with South American Countries

1425 Shri D. C. Sharma; Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

(a) the steps taken by Government to promote trade with the South American countries; and

(b) whether there is any proposal to study the scope of trade prospects with those countries?

The Deputy Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri Satish Chandra): (a) A number of steps have been taken to promote trade with South American countries e.g.:

- A Trade Agreement was concluded with Chile on the 10th March, 1960.
- (2) A delegation of the Engineering Export Promotion Council visited some of the countries in the area in 1960.
 - (3) A mission visited Argentina in 1960 for exploring the possibilities of exporting Railway equipment.
 - (4) Prospects of expansion of trade with these countries were explored through Indian Missions in these countries and their Missions in India.

(b) The possibilities of expansion of trade with the various counries are constantly explored.
