1549. Shri D. C. Sharma: Will the Minister of Works, Housing and Supply be pleased to state:

(a) what is the standard rent of 'D' type quarters in DIZ and Minto Road area in Delhi;

(b) whether it is a fact that a number of Government servants drawing more than Rs. 500 who are entitled to higher class quarters are occupying those quarters;

(c) if so, what is the number of such quarters and what is the rent they have to pay; and

(d) what steps are being taken to allot to them quarters of their own class?

The Minister of Works, Housing and Supply (Shri K. C. Reddy): (a) Rs. 67 per month for unorthodox 'D' type quarters (meant for officers drawing less than Rs. 750 but not less than Rs. 500 p.m.).

Rs. 53 per month for orthodox 'D' type quarters (meant for officers drawing less than Rs. 500 but not less than Rs. 250 p.m.).

(b) Yes.

(c) Unorthodox 'D' type—21 (occupied by officers drawing Rs. 750 and above).

Orthodox 'D' type-255

Rent is charged from the allottees at the rate of 10 per cent of their emoluments, or the pooled standard rent under FR-45A, whichever is less.

(d) The officers drawing Rs. 500 or more per month who are in occupation of D' type quarters which are below their own entitled class, are being shifted in their turn to quarters of their entitled class as and when vacancies occur.

## **Export of Glass Products**
