

An easing of the transport situation is expected when the capacity in the above Moghulsarai direction is increased from 1900 wagons to 2100 wagons per day from July, 1961 and the diversion of coal to certain consumers in the coastal states in the south and west by the sea route is given effect to. It may then be possible to step up movement of coal to U.P. still further.
