Industrial production is affected by a variety of factors including shortage of essential inputs throughout the country. The Ministry of Industry monitors the availability of industrial inputs and takes up the reported production snags with the concerned Department/authority for an early remedial action. The Departments of coal, Petroleum and Power have taken steps to improve the availability of industrial inputs. The production of coal has been augmented. However, overall performance of the coal sector crucially depends on the synchronised availability of power and adequate despatches of coal from pils-heads. Further, despite continuing increase in power generation in recent years, it has not been possible to eliminate the gap between requirement and supply since the demand of power has also continued to grow. It may be mentioned that the industrial production increased by 4.0 per cent during the first eight months of 1982-83.
