traffic accident, murder, theft, alcoholic offences, rape, adultery, embezzlement, forgery, illegal entry etc.

- (c) According to the latest information available with our Missions in the Gulf countries the number of Indian prisoners, countrywise, is: (1) BAHRAIN—3, (2) KUWAIT—95, (3) OMAN—35 (4) QATAR—22, (5) SAUDI ARABIA—79 and (6) UNITED ARAB EMIRATES—450.
- (d) Our Missions in the Gulf countries get in touch with the concerned authorities wherever possible, see that the trials are fairly conducted, and assist in securing early release.

Ships being built in Indian Shipyards

5036. SHRI CHINTAMANI JENA: Will the Minister of SHIPPING AND TRANS-PORT be pleased to state:

- (a) what are the particulars of the ships at present being built in Indian shipyards, their DWT and estimated cost; and
- (b) particulars of the organisations for whom these ships are being built and by when they will be ready and delivered to the parties concerned?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING AND TRANS-PORT (SHRI Z.R. ANSARI): (a) and (b). The required information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House in due course.

University Status to Jamia Millia

5037. SHRI ASHFAQ HUSSAIN: Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of main obstacles in the way of awarding a full fledged and formal university status to Jamia Millia of Delhi;
- (b) how many students are there in the technical, vocational and commercial graduation courses of this institution; and
- (c) the funds provided to this institution during the last three years by the University Grants Commission or Government?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE **EDUCATION** AND MINISTRIES OF AND SOCIAL WEL-CULTURE FARE (SHRIMATI SHEILA KAUL): (a) The Jamia Millia Islamia was declared as an institution 'deemed to be a university' in 1962 in terms of Section 3 of the UGC Act and all the provisions of the Act apply to Jamia Millia as if it were a university including the right to confer its own degrees. There is no proposal under the consideration of Government for declaring it as a full-fledged university.

- (c) The grants paid to Jamia during the last three years under Plan and Non-Plan are given below:
