**Research Work in Kashmiri Language** 

5038. SHRI ABDUL RASHID KABULI : PROF. SAIFUDDIN SOZ :

Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND CULTURE be pleased to state :

(a) names of the institutions in the country and abroad where Kashmiri language is being taught and research work is being done on this language;

(b) whether any financial and other help is being rendered for the development and propagation of Kashmiri language, in an outside; and (c) measures taken by Government to promote Kashmiri language and literature since the adoption of Constitution ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE EDUCATION AND MINISTRIES OF CULTURE AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI P.K. THUNGON) : (a) According to available information, Kashmiri is taught as additional/optional subject in classes IX and X and as elective subject in classes XI and XII in the State of Jammu and Kashmir. M.A. programme in Kashmiri and diploma in spoken/literary Kashmiri are being conducted by the University of Kashmir. Moscow University, USSR and University of Illinois U.S.A. also offer facilities for study and Research in Kashmiri.

(b) Under the Scheme of Assistance to Voluntary Organisations for promotion of Indian languages, financial assistance is given for the development of all Indian Languages including Kashmiri. The Government also gives awards on Kashmiri Books for Neo-literates. Kashmiri is also recognised by Sahitya Akademi for purposes of Akademi Awards.

(c) The Government has set up Northern Regional Language Centre, Patiala where in-service training is imparted to teachers of Kashmiri language also. 195 teachers have so far been trained. The Centre has brought out Kashmiri Phonetic Reader, Hindi-Kashmiri common Vocabulary and intensive course in Kashmiri and Common Vocabulary teaching material. The Centre has also established 36 Books Corners (mini libraries) in Kashmiri language in schools where the ex-teacher trainees are currently teaching.

The University of Kashmir has prepared manuscripts for 13 basic books. The trilingual dictionary (Hindi, Kashmiri, English/ Kashmiri, Hindi, English) is under preparation at the University.

## Revenue earnings from Taj Express in its tri-weekly run upto Gwallor

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI A.B.A. GHANI KHAN CHAU-DHURY) : (a) The revenue earnings of the railways are neither assessed nor compiled train-wise.

## Long distance trains being delayed on Agra Cantt.-Mathura-Delhi section

5040. SHRI DIGAMBER SINGH : Will

the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state :

(a) whether most of the long distance trains are held up or detained en-route on the Agra Cantt.-Mathura-Delhi section resulting in late arrival at New Delhi, Delhi and Hazrat Nizamuddin stations;

(b) if so, what are the reasons for these trains being delayed on this Section, when they mostly leave Agra Cantt. in time; and

(c) what steps he proposes to take to eliminate such late running causing considerable inconvenience to the travelling public ?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI A.B.A GHANI KHAN CHAUDHURY) : (a) to (c). Detention does occur sometimes on account of alarm chain pulling, signal failures, speed restrictions, out of path running on Itarsi-Agra section because of indiscriminate alarm chain pulling resulting in clash with commuter trains etc. Day-to-day watch is kept on such detentions at Divisional, Zonal and Railway Board's level and avoidable detentions are enquired into and staff responsible taken up.
