Opening of Railway Division at Chandigarh/Ambala

CHAND NARAIN 5051. PROF. PARASHAR: Will the Minister of RAIL-WAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have decided to open new railway Division either at Chandigarh or Ambala;
- (b) if so, the likely date by which it would be opened; and
- (c) if not, the likely date by which a decision would be taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI A.B.A. GHANI KHAN CHAUDHURY): (a) Yes. The Government have decided to set up a Divisional Headquarter at Ambala.

During the last one year, requests for opening new Kendriya Vidayalayas (Central Schools) were received from the Universities Kanpur, Rajasthan and Maharishi Dayanand (Rohtak). All of them have been advised to sponsor proposals in the prescribed manner. As and when formal proposals, complete in all respects, are received from them, these will be examined on merit along with other similar proposals.
