Low Market of Fertilizers

1964. SHRI A. NEELALOHITHA-DASAN NADAR: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that sale of chemicals and fertilizers is not picking up due to poverty of farmers;
- (b) if so, the corrective steps taken/ proposed:
- (c) whether Government will take steps to utilise fully vast quantities of animal dung and other organic matter and wastes as fertilizers and thereby conserve energy and also enrich our soil better than chemical fertilizers; and
- (d) whether as a first step Government will ban burning of animal and plant wastes in Delhi where this is happening at every street corner due to laziness of MCD/NDMC DDA staff ?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE (RAO BIRENDRA SINGH): (a) and (b) No Sir.

- (c) In order to promote the use of organic manures, a Central Sector Scheme on Development of Local Manurial Research through setting up of mechanical compost plants, sewage/sullage utilisation and installation of biogas plants was implemented during V plan period. As per decision of National Development Council, the programme was transfered to Sectors with effect from 1.4.1979. State Governments are being pursued to implement these programmes effectively.
- (d) For effective use of animal and Plant waste in Delhi, the Municipal Corporation of Delhi has already set up a Mechanical Compost Plant to convert it into manure. A similar plant is being set up by New Delhi Municipal Committee.
