# Potdar of Dharmanagar Treasury, Tripura

The Minister of State the Ministery of Home Affairs (Shri Datar): The District Magistarte and the Superintendent of Police, Tripura, had taken up the matter relating to extradition of Shri Jogesh Chandra Majumdar, Potdar, with their counterparts in East Pakistan. The Deputy Commissioner Noakhali, has informed the District Magistrate Tripura November, 1961, that a case has been instituted against the potdar in Noakhali District under Section 4 of Pakistan (Control of Entry) Act, which is still pending trial.

## Mining Projects in Kashmir
