The Deputy Minister of Law (Shri Hajarnavis): The Commission has so far toured in the following States:

Part of Madras, Kerala, Mysore, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Orissa, Assam,

Bihar, and a part of Rajasthan.

The Commission is proposing to complete its tour to Rajasthan and also visit a few places in Madhya Pradesh during December. This would leave Punjab, a part of Madras and a part of Madhya Pradesh to be covered. The Commission proposes to hold regular sittings in Delhi for discussing the draft report during January and February, 1962 and simultaneously pay short visits to a few important places yet remaining to be visited. Thereafter the Commission would be in a position to finalize its Report.
