Coal and Coke in Delhi

1693. **Shri Ram Garib:** Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that all the procuring agencies procured only 15 to 40 wagons of soft coke instead of 55 wagons per block rake in the months of August and September 1961 to create shortage of the commodity and shooting up of prices in the winter months in Delhi; and

(b) whether it is a fact that the open sale of coal/coke at the Mineral siding is being conducted with the knowledge of Civil Supplies Officer and Assistant Director?

Vigyan Mandirs in Andhra Pradesh

1694. **Shri Madhusudan Rao:** Will the Minister of Scientific Research and Cultural Affairs be pleased to state the number of Vigyan Mandirs to be opened in Andhra Pradesh during the Third Five Year Plan period?

The Deputy Minister of Scientific Research and Cultural Affairs (Dr. Mono Mohon Das): This is to be decided in consultation with the State Government, who have not yet formulated a phased programme for the opening of Vignan Mandirs, as required by the Government of India.

Archaeological Monuments in Andhra

(a) the amount (with break up) spent over the maintenance of various archaeological monuments in Andhra Pradesh during 1961-62; and

The Minister of Education (Dr. K. L. Srinivasaiah): The following grants have so far been paid by the University Grants Commission to Universities in Andhra Pradesh during 1961-62:—
