(a) whether the terms and conditions have been finalised between the State Trading Corporation and Japanese Steel Mills regarding purchase of 65/62 Grade Iron Ore during 1961—1963;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the result of the negotiations for the sale of 62/60 Grade Iron Ore; and

(d) ratio in which the Export Quotas for these contracts have been allotted to the States?

The Minister of Commerce (Shri Kanungo): (a) No, Sir.

(d) All exports of Iron Ore are made by the STC and purchases, in turn, are made from the mineowners, suppliers etc. having regard to the facilities available for transportation and shipping of ores.
