## Technical Personnel in Agriculture in Tripura

- 51. Shri Bangshi Thakur: Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:
- (a) whether there is a shortage of technical personnel in Agriculture Sector in Tripura; and
- (b) if so, the number of such personnel required for the implementation of the Third Five Year Plan as far as development of Agriculture in Tripura is concerned?

The Deputy Minister of Agriculture (Shri M. V. Krishnappa): (a) and (b). The required information is being collected and will be placed on the Table of the Sabha as soon as available.

## T.B. and Cancer Hospital at Chandnur (Orissa)

- Samantsinhar: Will the Dr. Minister of Health be pleased to state:
- (a) how much grant was given to the Orissa T.B. and Cancer Hospital at Chandpur in 1957-58;
- (b) how much of this amount has been spent for the benefit of the Cancer patients in that hospital; and
- (c) the total number of Cancer patients treated in the said Hospital uptill now?

The Minister of Health (Shri Karmarkar): (a) A grant of Rs. 1 lakh was paid to the Orissa T.B. and Cancer Hospitals Fund, Cuttack. Orissa during 1957-58 by the Government of India.

- (b) The grant was given for purchasing equipment for Thoracic Surgery, X-ray, Automatic Laundry etc., and for additional construction. was utilised for the purpose for which it was given.
- (c) The information is not readily available.

## Primary Health Centres

Dr. Samantsinhar: Will the Minister of Health be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of primary health centres and sub-centres established and hospital beds provided in each State and Union Territories by end of Second Plan period and the number of short-fall in each item separately:
  - (b) the reasons for the short-fall;
- (c) whether there is any proposal before Government to help the States in this regard; and
  - (d) if so, the details thereof?

The Minister of Health (Shrl Karmarkar): (a) and (b). The number of Primary Health Centres and sub-centres established and hospitalbeds provided in each State and Union Territory upto the end of the Second Five Year Plan and the short-fall in each case, where available, is as given in the statement laid on the Table of the House.
