## Landing and Berthing Facilities for Mechanised Fishing Boats

1004. SHRI CHINTAMANI JENA: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state :

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Central Government have called upon certain State Governments for establishing suitable small landing and berthing facilities on the coasts so that the number of small mechanised fishing boats operation on offshore could be increased:

- (c) the steps taken by those States to implement the directions given by the Central Government?

- (c) Since July, 1982, proposals have been forwarded only by Gujarat, Kerala, Orissa, Tamil Nadu and Lakshadweep Administration.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA): (a) The Sixth Plan allocation for major and medium irrigation projects in Madhya Pradesh is Rs. 780 crores.

(b) and (c) During the Sixth Plan. two medium irrigation projects viz. Pipliakumar and Majhgaon have been completed. Further, the following 10 major projects and 34 medium projects are likely to be completed by the end of Sixth Plan.
