Pak Spies in Jammu and Kashmir

Will the **Prime Minister** be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Pakistani spies have been planting bombs on the Jammu border as a result of which several persons have been killed and injured and several other mines have been discovered;

(b) whether it is also a fact that Pakistani spies have, of late, adopted a new strategy of 'hit and run' and sabotage activities have been increased;

(c) whether any protest has been made to the Pakistan Government in this regard; and

(d) the nature of the reply received and steps taken to ensure safety of the people of the State?

The Deputy Minister of External Affairs (Shrimati Lakshmi Menon):

(a) Pakistani spies planted bombs in the Mendhar and Poonch areas of the Jammu Province during the first two months of this year. No casualties were reported. One Pakistani spy was apprehended. A mine was also recovered.

(b) No new strategy among Pakistani spies of 'hit and run', has been noticed. The number of bomb explosion cases showed an increase compared with the corresponding period of 1961.
