- During the last three years i.e. 1980-81, 1981-82 & 1982-83, 33.7 lakh families have been provided house-sites.
- During 1983-84 (c) and (d) and 1984-85, 34.3 lakh families are expected to be provided house-sites.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI MOHAMMED USMAN ARIF): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Rs. 75 crores.

(c) and (d) A Committee has been formed with Secretary, Ministrys of works and Housing as chairman and representatives from the Planning Commission, Ministries of Finance; Health and Family Welfare, Rural Development and Agriculture as members. The additional funds under the new incentive scheme are to be released to various States/UTs based on their performance under the normal programmes. The Committee, in its first meeting. has decided to release Rs. 20 crores as first instalment on the basis of performance of the States/UTs upto end of June, 1983. The Committee has also decided that the performance of the States/UTs would be reviewed in January' 84 taking into consideration the physical achievements by various States/UTs upto the end of December, 1983 and release the balance amount of Rs. 55 crores on the basis of performance.

> Acquisition of land from Tribal Farmers by Forest Department
