- (b) if so, the names of the States where such bank of projects have been set up for the industrial growth;
- (c) whether any such bank of project for the growth of industries has been set up in Madhya Pradesh; and
- (d) if so, the details of its structure and steps taken for the growth of industries in Madhya Pradesh?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI PATTABHI RAMA RAO): (a) to (d) No such guidelines have been issued by this Ministery to set up a bank of Projects under the State Industries Development Corporation. Some of the State Industries Development Corporations including that of Madhya Pradesh have taken initiative on their own to get the project reports prepared for the benefit of new entrepreneurs through various consultancy organisations.

The State Government of Madhya Pradesh has announced special concessions for the development of new industries Growth Centres have been identified and necessary infrastructure is being developed there for the industrial development of the State.

## Discovery of Principles of Micro-Gravity

10589. SHRI ARJUN SETHI : Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any proposal for further Indo-Soviet joint space flights taking place in future;
  - (b) if so, the details in this regard;
- (c) whether the Indian scientists have set to discover the principles of micro-gravity by sending into space a silver germanium alloy with the first Indian cosmonaut, Sqn. Ldr. Rakesh Sharma; and
- (d) the details regarding the achivements at present in progress about microgravity in space in the conditions of weightlessness of Zero gravity in this historic experiment?

THE PRIME MINISTER (SHRIMATI INDIRA GANDHI): (a) and (b) No specific proposals are under consideration for further Indo-Soviet space flights.

(c) and (d) The principles of microgravity are known fairly well in open scientific literature especially from the beginning of the space era. The Indian scientific community is also aware of these and had held a few scientific seminars in the country before the present space flight. The Indian experiment is expected to give information about various aspects of properties of silver-germanium alloys and their behaviyour under microgravity conditions. The results of the experiments will be analysed on receipt.

## Demolition of Huts And Gumties on Encroached land

(SHRI PATTABHI RAMA RAO): (a) With the partial decontrol of cement in 1982, the Delhi Administration has beed issuing cement upto maximum ten bags for the residential dwellings in Delhi for repairs only. The entitlement for repairs upto maximum ten bags is restricted to a period of 12 months.
