THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONICS AND IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD AND CIVIL SUPPLIES (DR. M. S. SANJEEVI RAO): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir.

- (c) The mills have so far collected an amount of Rs. 30,400/- as share money from the grower members.
- (d) and (e) The mill is to be established at village Seron as mentioned in the Letter of Intent, However, the State Government can change the site keeping in view the availability of land, suitability of soil, underground water, approachability and rate of land, etc.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SPORTS, IN THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND HOUS-ING AND IN THE DEPART MENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) and (b) Housing, being a state subject, all the Social Housing Scheme are being implemented by the State Governments/UT Admns themselves. The Ministry of Works and Housing monitors the Rural House Sites-cum-Construction Assistance Scheme for landless workers which forms part of the Revised 20-Point Programme.
