**Shortage of Doctors and Medicines in
C.G.H.S. Dispensary, R.K. Puram,
New Delhi**

3120. SHRI MANOHAR LAL SAINI : Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state :

(a) what is the number of doctors sanctioned for Rama Krishna Puram Sector-I CGHS Dispensary and whether the sanctioned strength is in commensurate with the number of beneficiarics and whether all of the doctors remain on duty or only two-three doctors attend the dispensary ;

(b) whether medicines are generally out of stock/not available such as fesovit capsules and the store opens only in the forenoon putting the beneficiarics coming in the evening to avoidable inconvenience and the patients have to wait for the medicines for long time;

(c) whether the general upkeep and administration of the dispensary is far from satisfactory ; and

(d) if so, what steps Government propose to take to tighten up the functioning of the CGHS dispensaries all round ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (KUMARI KUMUD BEN M. JOSHI) : (a) C.G.H.S. Dispensary at R.K. Puram, Sector I, has a sanctioned strength of 9 doctors. The sanctioned strength is based on the norms evolved for sanction of staff in CGHS dispensaries.

(b) Most of the medicines are available in the dispensary. Fesovit capsule is not included in the CGHS formulary. The medicines are dispensed by the Pharmacists during working hours (morning and evening) through the dispensing counters and not by Storekeeper.

(c) and (d). The General upkeep of the dispensary is satisfactory. Surprise visits are paid to ensure punctuality, cleanliness etc.

New Railway Lines in Andhra Pradesh

3121. SHRI G. BHOOPATHY : Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state ;

(a) the number of new railway lines sanctioned for Andhra Pradesh and the location and other salient features of these lines ;

(b) the nature of progress achieved on laying the new line between Patancheru in Medak district and Ramagundam in Karimnagar District ; and

(c) which are the important places covered by Patancheru and Ramagundam line enroute ?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI A.B.A. GHANI KHAN CHOUDHURY) : (a) The following five new railway lines have been sanctioned in Andhra Pradesh :—

(b) A Preliminary Engineering-cum-Traffic Survey for construction of a railway line from Patancheru in Medak district to Peddapalli, an existing station on the Kazipet-Balharshah G.T. route, 17 Kms. from Ramagundam, was carried out during 1980-81. The report of the survey revealed that the proposed line 300.58 Kms. in length would cost Rs. 95.67 crores. In view of the shortage of funds and heavy commitments already in hand, it has not been able to consider this project at present.

Testing of Drugs Imported by Private Company

3122. SHRI A.K. BALAN : Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state :

(a) whether there are any private agencies that are importing drugs at present ; and

(b) if so, whether any of the drugs imported by them have been found sub-standard during the last one year.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (KUMARI KUMUD BEN M. JOSHI) : (a) At present drugs are being imported by drug manufacturers and also importers who are in the private sector. In addition, certain canalised items are being imported by the State Trading Corporation.

(b) Some samples of imported drugs on test in the Central Drugs Laboratory, Calcutta, Central Indian Pharmacopoeia Laboratory, Ghaziabad and Central Research Institute, Kasauli have been found to be of not of standard quality. Consignments of these drugs have not been permitted to be released and the Customs authorities have been advised to take action as provided under the Drugs and Cosmetics Rules.
