- (c) and (d) There were four vacancies in the grade of Deputy Director (Pay Scale) Rs. 1100-1600) in the Photo Division. According to the recruitment rules. these posts were to be filled up by promotion on the basis of selection from amongst Photographic Officer with 8 years regular service in the grade. There were 11 officers in the consideration out of which two zone. officers belonged to S.C. Community at S No. 5 and 11, but none belonged to Community. The DPC chaired by a member of the Union Public Service Commission met in January, 1983 and forwarded a panel of four names for four vacancies. The recommendations of the DPC in respect of a scheduled caste officer at serial No 5 are in a sealed cover as a vigilance case is still pending agaist him. The panel forwarded by the Commission was duly accepted by the competent authority rnd implemented, after following the prescribed produce for reservation of the vacancy to be an officer belonging to scheduled tribe.
