**Promotion to the Post of Deputy Director
(Photo Division)**

SHRI LALA RAM KEN : Will
the Minister of INFORMATION AND
BROADCASTING be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that promotions
to four vacancies in the post of Dy. Director
(Photo Division) were made on the basis
of D.P.C. held in January, 1983 ;

(b) if so, whether out of these four
vacancies, one each was reserved for
Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes
respectively ;

(c) whether reserved category candidates
were available in the feeder cadre of Photo
Officers and were also eligible for promo-
tions ;

(d) if so, whether the eligible candidates
were promoted, if not, the reasons therefor ;
and

(e) if no Scheduled Tribe officer in the
feeder cadre was eligible for promotion,

whether the eligible Scheduled Caste candidate was promoted against Scheduled Tribe vacancy by applying the principle of exchange of reservation in pursuance of DP & AR O.M. No. 10/41/73—Estt. (SCT) dated 20 July, 1974, if not, the reasons therefor ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI H.K.L. BHAGAT) : (a) and (b) Yes, Sir.

(c) and (d) There were four vacancies in the grade of Deputy Director (Pay Scale Rs. 1100-1600) in the Photo Division. According to the recruitment rules, these posts were to be filled up by promotion on the basis of selection from amongst Photographic Officer with 8 years regular service in the grade. There were 11 officers in the consideration zone, out of which two officers belonged to S.C. Community at S. No. 5 and 11, but none belonged to S.T. Community. The DPC chaired by a member of the Union Public Service Commission met in January, 1983 and forwarded a panel of four names for four vacancies. The recommendations of the DPC in respect of a scheduled caste officer at serial No. 5 are in a sealed cover as a vigilance case is still pending against him. The panel forwarded by the Commission was duly accepted by the competent authority and implemented, after following the prescribed procedure for de-reservation of the vacancy to be filled by an officer belonging to scheduled tribe.

(e) The facts in this regard were brought to the notice of the Union Public Service Commission who advised that the proceedings of the DPC should be reviewed. Accordingly, the case has been referred to the Commission for convening a review Departmental Promotion Committee.

Import of Newsprint to meet shortage during 1984-85
