privileges the press often finds it difficult to give elaborate coverage to Parliamentary proceedings without attracting privilege;

(b) whether such a situation also occasionally leads to confrontation between press, Parliament and judiciary; and

(c) if so, to avoid such an undesirable confrontation will the proposal for codification of Parliamentary privileges be examined in depth and implemented ?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMEN-TARY AFFAIRS, SPORTS AND WORKS AND HOUSING) SHRI BUTA SINGH): (a) to (c) The matters contained in the question were considered by the Second Press Commission. The Commission vide para 110 of Chapter IV of its Report has recommended that the privileges of Parliament and State Legislatures should be codified as early as possible. The recommendations of the Second Press Commission are under con ideration of the Government.

Central Cattle Breeding Farms

8401. SHRI B. D. SINGH : Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government operate Central Cattle Breeding Farms; if so, farm-wise location, date of start, expenditure incurred plan-wise on each, number of cows in milk. those dry, heifers, female calves and bulls, breed-wise on 1st of January, April, July and December, 1980, 1981, 1982, 1983 and month-wise in 1984;

(b) whether Government have constituted any committee to examine objectives and functioning of these farms; if so, when and particulars of each nominee thereon; and

(c) whether Government included in this evaluation committee any former Animal Husbandry Director of States to provide comparativity and objectivity and if so, particulars thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA) : (a) Yes, Sir. The location and dates of start of the seven Central Cattle Breeding Farms are as under :
