ments have also been advised to give special preference to SC/ST enterpreneurs in matters relating to disbursement of loans, training and other assistance. The Small Industries Development Organisation has not issued any directions/orders reserving quota of raw materials for units manned by members of SC/STs. IDBI has advised elgible credit institution about reduction in promotors contibution to viable projects promoted by SC/ST entrepreneurs to 5% of project cost exclusive of said capital assistance. The relaxation in promotors contribution has been extended to refinaning of term loans including composite loans upto Rs. 25,000/. All SFCS and eligible banks under refinance scheme have been instructructed to implement these guidelines.
