## Letters of intent for Industries in Rayalaseema Area

5308. SHRI K. OBUI REDDY: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHR! PATTA-BHI RAMA RAO): (a) to (d) Details regarding industries already existing in various regions of the country, including Rayalascema Area, are not being maintained centrally in the Ministry of Industry. Secretariat for Industrial Approvals in the Ministry of Industry is, however, maintaining information in respect of letters of intent and industrial licences issued under the provisions of Industries (Development & Regulation) Act. All industrial licence applications are

considered on merit taking into account various techno-economic factors, such as, demand and supply, capacity already licensed, availability of raw materials, locational constraints and viability of the scheme.

During the years 1979 to 1983, 44 letters of intent were issued under the provisions of Industries (Development & Regulation) Act for locating industries in Chittoor, Cuddapah, Anantpur and Kurnool districts of Rayalaseema Area of Andhra Pradesh State. Details, viz, name and address of the undertaking, item of manufacture, capacity and location, of letters of intent issued are being published regularly by the Indian Investment Centre in their Monthly News Letter'. Copies of this publication are regularly being sent to the Parliament Library.
